PRODUCT TYPE/S	Nail polishes
PRODUCT NAME/S	Max Factor Nailfinity
HAZARDS OF PRODUCT	Eyes: Can cause irritation of the conjunctiva. Ingestion: Can lead to nausea and irritation of the gastrointestinal tract. Skin: Can cause irritation if left in contact with the skin, undiluted, for long periods. Inhalation: Can cause irritation of the nose, throat and respiratory tract.
FIRST AID	Eyes: Rinse immediately with copious amounts of fresh water and seek medical advice. Ingestion: Drink large quantity of water. Seek prompt medical advice. Skin: Wash well with soap and water to remove. If irritation persists, seek medical advice. Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. In the event of breathing difficulties seek prompt medical advice.
SAFETY OF HANDLING/USE	Respiratory protection: Not applicable for normal usage. This would only be required in the event of multiple bulk product/bottle spills. Ventilation: Good ventilation is recommended with the use of this product but normal building ventilation should be perfectly adequate. Special ventilation is only necessary in the event of multiple bulk product/bottle spills. Protective gloves: Not applicable for normal consumer usage. Other protective equipment: Not applicable for normal consumer usage. Eye protection: Avoid contact with eyes.
EMERGENCY MEASURES	Spillage: Spillage of a single bottle: 1). If split on a hard surface, remove excess with tissues, and finish with warm water and detergent. 2). If split on a carpet, leave to dry and then physically remove solid matter. Bulk product spillage: 1) Turn off/disconnect any possible sources of ignition. Extinguish any cigarettes/open flame. 2) Wipe up excess. 3) Use hot water to wipe down floor. 4) Wipe area dry. Disposal: Domestic disposal should be through the normal household waste. The disposal of bulk material should comply with local waste disposal controls or Regulations. An authorised licenced contractor should be used for waste handling/disposal. Fire: Flammable. Use a CO ₂ or dry powder fire extinguisher.
STORAGE	Store conventionally in a clean, dry place away from heat, contamination and other products. Keep out of reach of young children.
